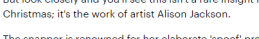


## A right royal Christmas! The Duchess of Cambridge kisses Prince William under the mistletoe while the Queen takes a group selfie (but all is not what it seems)

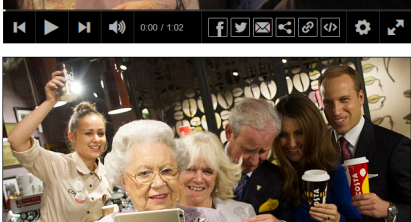

In another shot, a Prince Charles lookalike can be seen helping his wife, Camilla, slip into her Santa-themed slippers.

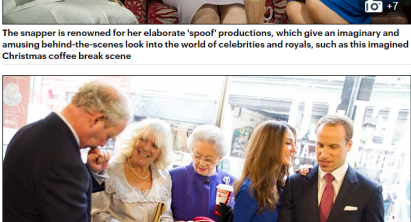
### Royal family lookalikes spotted taking a festive selfie

Earlier this week, the Duchess of Cambridge released a snap she took of six-month-old Princess Charlotte.

The two new photos of the fourth in line to the throne were released by Kensington Palace as a means of thanking the public for its support and interest since the couple's daughter was born on May 2.

They were taken by keen photographer Kate, 33, at Anmer Hall, the Cambriges' ten-bedroom Norfolk mansion, in early November. The couple are basing themselves there with their family while William works as a pilot for the East Anglia Air Ambulance.

They show that Charlotte, not seen in public since her christening in July, is growing up fast. She is able to sit almost unaided in a 'shabby chic'-look armchair covered with a green and beige checked fabric.
