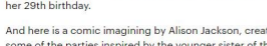


Party like Pippa! As Kate's sister launches a book on how to throw the perfect party, a cheeky preview spoof from Alison Jackson

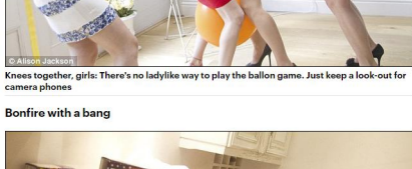
Naughty Easter nibbles

Bonfire with a bang

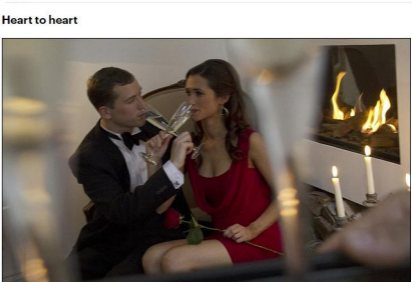


Hooray for Iceland: Be sure to hide the empty boxes, though

Oh no, the balloon's gone up: Obviously, even posh tots can get out of control. I suppose that was Vimpto I gave them, not Red Bull?

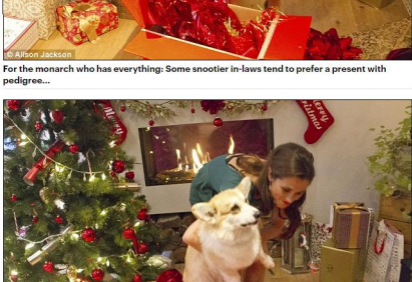


Your hostess is trolleys: The clearing up can wait until I've finished off the vodka
