Spoof photographer Alison Jackson imagines what Christmas Day might be like for Kate, Wills and George this year

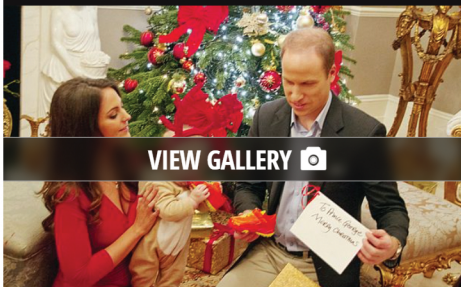
